For the past 23 years, Will County Take Back the Night has been a leader in our community to call for an end to violence against women. We rely on generous donations from sponsors like you to continue this mission.

We invite you to join us at the 2019 Will County Take Back the Night rally, which will take place on Thursday, October 3, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. at Joliet Central High School in the new student center. Our guest speaker will be Dr. M. Susan Scanlon, a local gynecologist and author of "The Gyne's Guide for College Women: How to Have a Healthy, Safe and Happy Four Years." After hearing Dr. Scanlon's keynote address, we will host a candlelight vigil and march to honor the Will County women and children who have been murdered over the past decade. Community organizations will be there with resources and information available to help survivors and their families.

In addition to the rally, Will County Take Back the Night also hosts educational programs for high school students, awards an annual \$1,000 scholarship to a survivor of intimate partner abuse, and last year granted \$8,000 to local nonprofit agencies that work directly with women, children and families whose lives have been affected by violence. This year we are also hosting a workshop in November to teach self-defense and general safety tips to high school girls. Sponsorship donations allow our organization to cover the costs of these important programs.
